**AN ORDER CONCURRING WITH THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO APPROVE A TEMPORARY USE PERMIT FILED BY BOBBY SULLIVAN TO ALLOW FOR A RECREATIONAL VEHICLE ON A 30.1-ACRE PARCEL OF LAND.**

WHEREAS, the Harrison County Board of Supervisors finds and does so determine under Section 401.01.a. and based upon the recommendation of the Harrison County Planning Commission and county departments, as well as its existing needs and development, and based upon a reasonable consideration of the character of the district and neighborhood and suitability for particular purposes, that the property which is generally described as being 30.1-acres located at 11178 County Farm Rd, should be granted a temporary use permit not to exceed 6 months with a favorable recommendation by the Planning Commission. 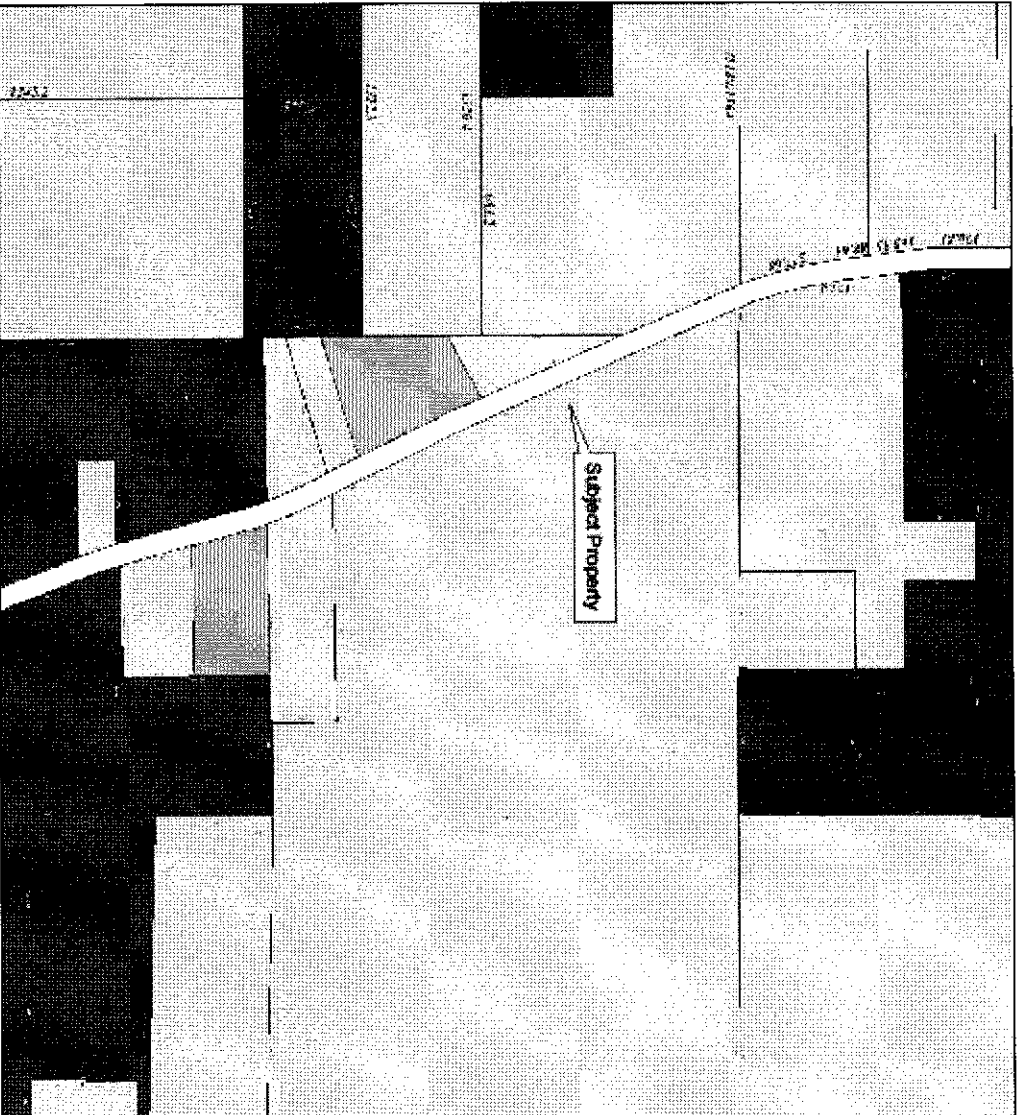
