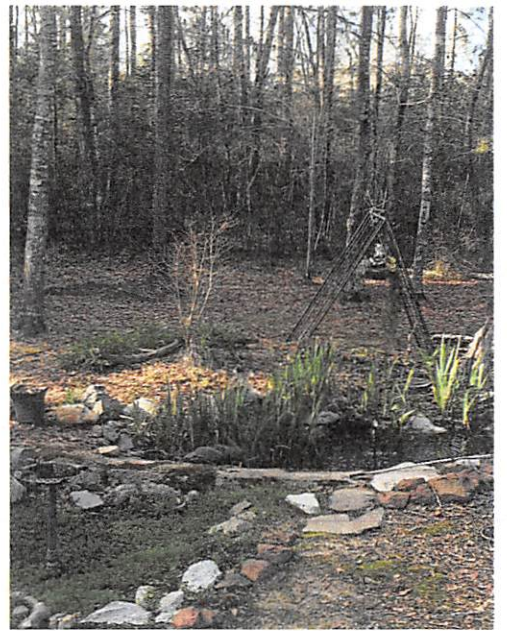
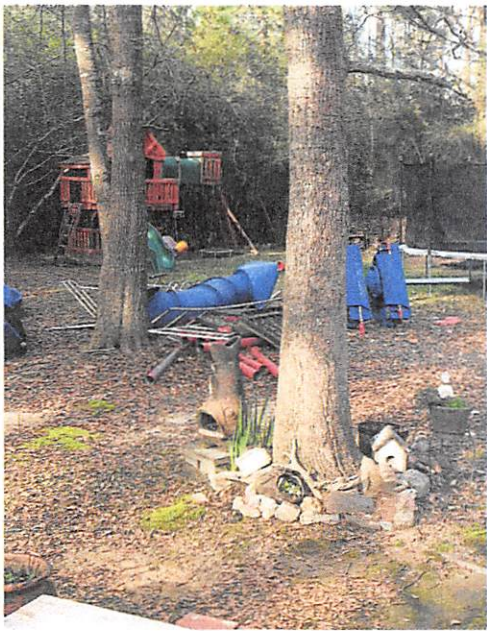
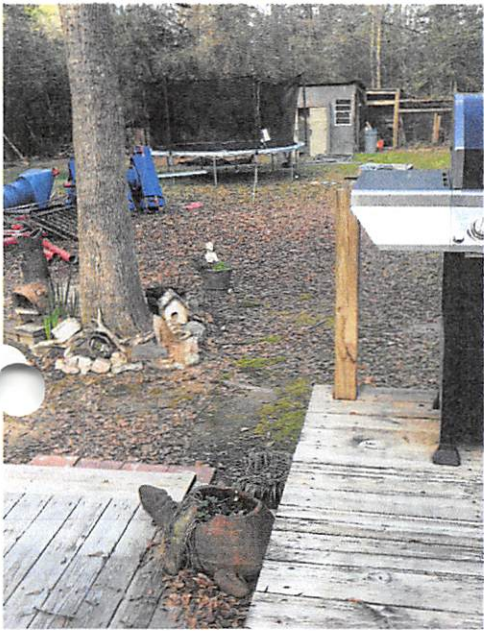
C. area where bullets have come through yard @ 20145 Stiles Rd.

On 24 February 2018, Deputy French responded to 20136 Stiles Road in regards to a disturbance of peace. Upon arrival Deputy French spoke to Jessica Akers who stated her neighbor, Christopher Mullett residing at 20161 Park Court, shoots his guns on a daily basis and is causing a disturbance. Akers stated she found a bullet on the back porch of the residence. Akers stated on several different occasions she has heard bullets flying by her residence while she was outside. Deputy Moon collected the bullet and placed it into evidence at the Harrison County Sheriff's Office.

Deputy French spoke to a neighbor, Jeremy Altman residing at 20110 Stiles Road, who stated that he can also hear the bullets while Mullett shoots on a daily basis. Altman stated he is scared to sit outside and do yard work while Mullett is shooting because he is scared to get shot.

Deputy French advised everyone that is being disturbed that they could sign charges against Mullett for disturbing the peace. Akers and Altman stated that they would sign charges at a later date.

Deputy French responded to 20161 Park Court to speak to Mullett but had negative contact at the residence.

2016 Mississippi Code

Title 45 - Public Safety and Good Order

Chapter 9 - Weapons

Restrictions Upon Local Regulation of Firearms or Ammunition (§§ 45-9-51 - 45-9-57)

§ 45-9-51. Prohibition against adoption of certain ordinances

§ 45-9-53. Exceptions; procedure for challenging ordinances; county or municipal programs to purchase weapons from citizens

§ 45-9-55. Employer not permitted to prohibit transportation or storage of firearms on employer property; exceptions; certain immunity for employer

§ 45-9-57. Regulation by county of discharge of any firearm within platted subdivision

Universal Citation: MS Code § 45-9-53 (2016)

(1) This section and Section 45-9-51 do not affect the authority that a county or municipality may have under another law:

(a) To require citizens or public employees to be armed for personal or national defense, law enforcement, or another lawful purpose;

(b) To regulate the discharge of firearms within the limits of the county or municipality. A county or municipality may not apply a regulation relating to the discharge of firearms or other weapons in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the county or municipality or in an area annexed by the county or municipality after September 1, 1981, if the firearm or other weapon is:

(i) A shotgun, air rifle or air pistol, BB gun or bow and arrow discharged:

1. On a tract of land of ten (10) acres or more and more than one hundred fifty (150) feet from a residence or occupied building located on another property; and

2. In a manner not reasonably expected to cause a projectile to cross the boundary of the tract; or

(ii) A center fire or rim fire rifle or pistol or a muzzle-loading rifle or pistol of any caliber discharged:

1. On a tract of land of fifty (50) acres or more and more than three hundred (300) feet from a residence or occupied building located on another property; and

2. In a manner not reasonably expected to cause a projectile to cross the boundary of the tract;

Universal Citation: MS Code § 45-9-57 (2016)

A county may regulate the discharge of any firearm or weapon, other than a BB gun, within any platted subdivision. However, no county may prohibit the discharge of any firearm or weapon on land, if such firearm or weapon is discharged in a manner not reasonably expected to cause a projectile from such firearm or weapon to travel across any property line without permission of the property owner.

SENATE BILL NO. 2857
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR WILLFULLY DISCHARGING A
2 FIREARM TOWARD THE DWELLING OF ANOTHER AND CAUSING DAMAGE TO THE
3 DWELLING OR DOMESTICATED ANIMALS OR LIVESTOCK; TO REQUIRE THE
4 DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE, FISHERIES AND PARKS TO DEVELOP A SAFETY
5 PROGRAM FOR HIKING, HORSEBACK RIDING AND WALKING TRAILS IN
6 WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREAS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. A person who willfully discharges his firearm
9 toward the dwelling of another, causing property damage to the
10 dwelling or any domesticated animal or livestock, is guilty of a
11 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than One Thousand
12 Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisonment not exceeding twelve (12)
13 months in the county jail, or both.

14 SECTION 2. (1) The department shall clearly designate and
15 mark hiking, horseback riding and walking trails on state-owned
16 wildlife management areas. The department shall develop and
17 implement a safety program and regulations for the use of the
18 trails during any gun season.

19 (2) The department is directed to enter into a memorandum of
20 understanding with the USDA Forest Service to develop and
21 implement a safety program and regulations for the use of hiking,
22 horseback riding and walking trails during any gun season in
23 wildlife management areas on national forest lands.

24 SECTION 3. A county may regulate the discharge of any
25 firearm or weapon, other than a BB gun, within any platted
26 subdivision. However, no county may prohibit the discharge of any
27 firearm or weapon on land, if such firearm or weapon is discharged
28 in a manner not reasonably expected to cause a projectile from

29 such firearm or weapon to travel across any property line without
30 permission of the property owner.

31 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
32 and after July 1, 2010.
